The Truth about Witchcraft/Sorcery/Astrology Deuteronomy 18:10-14

I. "When you enter the land the Lord your God is giving you, do not imitate the detestable customs of those nations. ¹º No one among you is to sacrifice his son or daughter in the fire, practice divination, tell fortunes, interpret omens, practice sorcery, ¹¹ cast spells, consult a medium or a spiritist, or inquire of the dead. ¹² Everyone who does these acts is detestable to the Lord, and the Lord your God is driving out the nations before you because of these detestable acts. ¹³ You must be blameless before the Lord your God. ¹⁴ Though these nations you are about to drive out listen to fortune-tellers and diviners, the Lord your God has not permitted you to do this. Deuteronomy 18:9-14

II. Key words:

- a. Astronomy: is a natural science that studies celestial objects and the phenomena that occur in the cosmos. It uses mathematics, physics, and chemistry.
- b. Astrology is the belief that the positions of celestial bodies like the sun, moon, and planets at the time of a person's birth can influence their personality and life events
- c. Cults: a relatively small group of people having beliefs or practices, especially relating to religion, that are regarded by others as strange or sinister or as imposing excessive control over members.
- d. Occult: clandestine, hidden, or secret. In its modern iteration, occult practices center on

- harnessing these hidden powers and bending the laws of nature to benefit oneself.
- e. Horoscope an astrological chart or diagram representing the positions of the Sun, Moon, planets, astrological aspects and angles at the time of an event
- f. Sorcerer is a person who uses magic, often by seeking to control and wield supernatural power.
- g. Witch witches typically gain their power through ritual, nature, and sometimes pacts with supernatural entities while Sorcerers are born with innate magical abilities,
- h. Zodiak: an imaginary belt in the heavens that includes the apparent paths of most of the planets and is divided into 12 star groups or signs.
- III. Witchcraft: the practice of magic, especially for evil purposes; the use of spells:
 - a. Witchcraft is Divination: ⁶They saw false visions and their divinations were a lie. They claimed, "This is the Lord's declaration," when the Lord did not send them, yet they wait for the fulfillment of their message. ⁷Didn't you see a false vision and speak a lying divination when you proclaimed, "This is the Lord's declaration," even though I had not spoken? Ezekiel 13:6-7
 - b. Witchcraft is Rebellion **1**: opposition to one in authority or dominance, rebellion occurs when someone rejects the authority of God or the legitimate authorities established by God. Romans 13:1-4
 - c. ²³ For rebellion is like the sin of divination,

- and defiance is like wickedness and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, he has rejected you as king.1 Samuel 15:23
- IV. Astrology: the study of the movements and relative positions of celestial bodies interpreted as having an influence on human affairs and the natural world.
 - a. Astronomy is the branch of science which deals with celestial objects, space, and the physical universe as a whole. Not the focus of this lesson.
 - b. Horoscopes: a forecast of a person's future, typically including a delineation of character and circumstances, based on the relative positions of the stars and planets at the time of that person's birth.
 - Be careful that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deceit based on human tradition, based on the elements of the world, rather than Christ. Colossians 2:8
 - ¹⁰ No one among you is to sacrifice his son or daughter in the fire, practice divination, tell fortunes, interpret omens, practice sorcery, ¹¹ cast spells, consult a medium or a spiritist, or inquire of the dead.

c. Astrology is weak:

Deuteronomy 18:10

 ⁴I, Nebuchadnezzar, was at ease in my house and flourishing in my palace. ⁵I had a dream, and it frightened me; while in my bed, the images and visions in my mind alarmed me. ⁴So I issued a decree to bring all the wise men of Babylon to me in order that they might make the dream's interpretation known to me. ⁷When the magicians, mediums, Chaldeans, and diviners came in, I told them the dream, but they could not make its interpretation known to me. Daniel 4:4-7

- d. Astrology can not one save from the future:
 - ¹³ You are worn out with your many consultations. So let the astrologers stand and save you— those who observe the stars, those who predict monthly what will happen to you. ¹⁴ Look, they are like stubble; fire burns them. They cannot rescue themselves from the power of the flame. This is not a coal for warming themselves, or a fire to sit beside! Isaiah 47:13-14

V. Sorcery

- a. The use of witchcraft or magic; communication with the devil or with a familiar spirit; an irresistible influence or fascination
- b. Satanic Control, Period!
- c. The traditional view of sorcery is what the devil wants us to see. A sorcerer/witch is no more a woman in a black hat or a man in a hood than the devil is a creature in a red suit with a pitch fork.
- d. An Abomination to God: ¹⁰ No one among you is to sacrifice his son or daughter in the fire, practice divination, tell fortunes, interpret omens, practice sorcery, ¹¹ cast spells, consult a medium or a spiritist, or inquire of the dead. ¹² Everyone who does these acts is detestable to the Lord, and the Lord your God is driving out the nations before you because of these detestable acts. Deuteronomy 18:10-12
- e. Sorcery pervert judgment.

- A man named Simon had previously practiced sorcery in that city and amazed the Samaritan people, while claiming to be somebody great. Acts 8:9
- You foolish Galatians! Who has cast a spell on you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified? Galatians 3:1
- f. Sorcery can be among believers Acts 8:11-25
 - …¹³ Even Simon himself believed. And after he was baptized, he followed Philip everywhere and was amazed as he observed the signs and great miracles that were being performed. Acts 8:12-13
 - ¹8 When Simon saw that the Spirit^[g] was given through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money, ¹9 saying, "Give me this power also so that anyone I lay hands on may receive the Holy Spirit.", Acts 8:18
 - ²² Therefore repent of this wickedness of yours, and pray to the Lord that, if possible, your heart's intent may be forgiven. Acts 8:22
- g. Primary tools of sorcery and witchcraft are:
 - **1.** Manipulation: Manipulators use position and power to dictate the outcome of a situation thereby reducing or removing the Holy Spirit Role in a believers life
 - There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. Romans 8:1 KJV
 - **2.** Intimidation frightens or overawes (someone), especially in order to make them do what one wants.

- 10 Then the Philistine said, "I defy the ranks of Israel today. Send me a man so we can fight each other!" 11 When Saul and all Israel heard these words from the Philistine, they lost their courage and were terrified.. 1 Samuel 17:10
- Domination is to having a commanding influence on or exercising control over someone.
 - You foolish Galatians! Who has cast a spell on you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified? Galatians 3:1
- VI. How to survive Witchcraft, Sorcery and Astrology
 - a. Know that you are saved Therefore, brothers and sisters, make every effort to confirm your calling and election, because if you do these things you will never stumble 2 Peter 1:10
 - b. Know that witchcraft(Evil Control) is a Sin: 19 Now the works of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, moral impurity, promiscuity, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatreds , strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambitions, dissensions, factions, 21 envy, drunkenness, carousing, and anything similar. I am warning you about these things—as I warned you before—that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians 5:19-21
 - c. Repent of your sin: 2 And he[a] responded to them, "Do you think that these Galileans were

- more sinful than all the other Galileans because they suffered these things? 3 No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish as well. Luke 13:2-3
- d. Immerse yourself in the Word of God: ¹¹ I have treasured your word in my heart so that I may not sin against you. Psalm 119:11
- e. Stand in the Name of Jesus: ...¹⁴ Stand, therefore, with truth like a belt around your waist, righteousness like armor on your chest..., Ephesians 6:13-18
